

FLORIDA ASSOCIATION OF FAMILY AND CONSUMER SCIENCES Graduate Scholarship Information (\$500)

Eligibility

1. The recipient must be a member in good standing of the Florida Association of Family and Consumer Sciences.
2. The applicant's graduate program must be in some area of the Family and Consumer Sciences field.
3. The applicant must have achieved a grade point average of at least 3.0 (B) during the last 60 semester hours of undergraduate study or an overall grade point average of at least 3.0 (B) during graduate study, and possess potentialities for leadership and scholarly attainment in Family and Consumer Sciences.
4. The recipient must have been admitted to a graduate program in Family and Consumer Sciences in an accredited university.
5. The applicant must be sponsored by his/her district Family and Consumer Sciences Association.
6. A recipient may receive the scholarship only once.
7. Other things being equal, preference will be given to applicants expecting to pursue professional Family and Consumer Sciences related careers in Florida.

Method of Payment

Upon recommendation by the Chairperson of the Scholarship Committee and the authorization of the FAFCS President, The Treasurer will transmit a check to the recipient. This will be predicated upon validation of student enrollment by the Dean or Department Chairperson for the current semester in the designated college of university.

Due date: January 30, of the current year.
